1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as determined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of U.S. Sailing will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions
- 1.3 Equipment is required to conform to the rules of the International Audi Melges 20 Class Association

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

The regatta is open to all class approved Audi Melges 20s. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form by Thursday, August 20

4. FEES

The required fees are as follows:

Postmarked after August 15: \$400

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions (SIs) will be available at registration. The owner and/or boat representative must sign for them.

7. VENUE

The Macatawa Bay Yacht Club, located at 2157 South Shore Drive, Macatawa, MI 49434, +1 (616) 335-5815.

8. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward with the discretion to finish downwind.

9. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat will neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cellular phones.





11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top five skipper and crew. The Audi Melges 20 National Championship Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision To Race. The Organizing Authority (OA) will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
